Victory Golf Pass will once again be utilized by the club with a link set up for purchase and the Golf Improvement plan which was started last year at Springfield Driving Range will be expanded. Mike Holland discussed the Handicap process and procedures for the New Year since we'll be using a new program, Focus 2000. Glen Dobson spoke on Tournament Rules. John Jones discussed the Club Match Play selection process.

Two notable Tournaments are the Member/Guest Outing scheduled for May 1<sup>st</sup> and the Del Val/Omega Psi Phi Scholarship Tournament scheduled for May 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Open Discussion**

It was reported by Anton Burnette that Del Val's hosting of the Pro-Duffers USA National Tournament & Convention has been pushed back from 2012 to 2014. The National Committee wanted to fit the new chapters in the rotation for 2012 and have the founding chapters host the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary National Tournament & Convention in 2013. Many members were not happy and President Spriggs decided to follow up and speak with National President Chuck Stradford.

Vice-President John Jones welcomed everyone to the New Year for Del Val.
